

Disc Golf Daily Play Information, Rules, & Etiquette

What: DISC GOLF WITH GOLF CARTS AVAILABLE FOR DAILY PLAY (Limited Hours)

Where: The Golf Club at Camelot W192 State Road 67 Just east of US 41 (Shooter's Supply/Lomira Exit)

When: Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays: Disc golf tee times available from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM MUST MAKE TEE TIME IN ADVANCE. Expanded hours and days may become available as we get later into the season.

18 Holes will be available from September 22nd through November at least. Future availability of this temporary course will depend on the amount of play it receives, food and beverage sales, as well as the etiquette of the disc golfers. If you want this to be available in the future, please respect the fact they are allowing us to use the course and their beautiful clubhouse. Please respect the staff and the golfers playing on adjacent and nearby holes, and follow their rules by getting carts back to the clubhouse by dark even if you haven't finished your round.

There will be a Lost and Found for any discs found on the course. Please either deposit any discs you find into the drop box by #1 tee or leave with the pro shop staff. We will do our best to locate the owners.

PROPERTY RULES:

NO CARRY ON BEVERAGES. Please purchase all beverages at the clubhouse prior to heading out or from the beverage cart (when/if available).

ETIQUETTE:

Golfers have the right of way so please allow them their space. If you are the first tee-time after golfers, you must stay behind them . . . please do not push them making them feel like they are playing too slow. Simply enjoy your time outside and throw only when the golfers are out of your way on each hole.

Please keep the noise level to a minimum especially if golfers are nearby. No radios or excessively loud Bluetooth speakers. If you throw a great shot, it's ok to get excited but keep in mind golfers typically prefer quiet when putting on the greens or addressing the ball as it takes more concentration than we need while throwing a disc so being aware of who and where people may be around you is important.

DO NOT DRIVE onto golf tees (usually a built-up area) or within 30 feet of golf greens. And lastly be respectful with the golf carts. It is a privilege to be able to use them on a beautiful course so let's please make sure we can keep doing this in the future.
